1.01: ACADEMICS : Students in the examination classes (JS3 and SS3) sat for the following external examinations: For Js3: They sat for the Anambra State Basic certificate Examination (state BECE)

For SS3: They are presently writing the National Examination Council (NECO) SSCE Examinations.

The promotion examinations for others classes were conducted accordingly. Parents/guardians should endeavour to access their sons/wards results Online (www.bishopcrowtherseminaryawka.com) on Thursday, July 28, 2022. Please, be reminded that promotion into the next class is at an average of 50%.

1.02: COMPETITION:

- We took 1st and 2nd positions in the Senior and Junior categories of Inter Schools Science quiz competitions respectively, organized by the Province of the Niger Education Board.
- The Seminary participated in the one day Students' Congress organized by FUTUREHOLDS WINNERS NETWORK held on 30th September, 2021
- BCS Awka took part in the NNPC quiz competition held at St. John's Secondary School, Awka on the 7th day of June, 2022. The results are yet to be published
- BCS Awka took 1st position in the final stage of the written science quiz competition and, 2nd position in the final stage of the oral science quiz competition of the Science Teachers' Association of Nigeria (STAN) Anambra State chapter. We shall be among the team and schools that will represent Anambra State at the National level come August 2022.

2.02: BCS ACCESS CODE: The Seminary has introduced BCS Annual Access Code Card for assessing the Seminary website for tests/examination and, it is also the student's identity card. To this effect, every student is expected to pay the sum of Three thousand Naira (#3000) only for a copy of BCS Annual Access Code Card into the seminary **Access Bank Account**

2.03: ACCOMODATIONS: Placement into the dormitory/hostel for the next academic session will be according to student payment of fees (first pay first serve method). The seminary shall not tolerate any form of favoritism.

2.04: REMEDIAL CLASSES: There shall be EXTRA/REMIDAL CLASSES for students whose ANNUAL CUMMULATIVE AVERAGE fall between 40%-49.9% on Saturday August 13, 2022 to Saturday September 10, 2022. It is compulsory for students whose **AVERAGE CUMULATIVE AVERAGE fall between 40%-49.9% and are invited/shortlisted. The fee is thirty five thousand Naira only (#35,000.00)**. Those not invited/fail to attend shall either repeat their classes or advised to change school. The names of students shortlisted for the Remedial Classes shall be the Seminary website on Thursday, August 04, 2022.

2.05: SCHOOL FEES: Basically remains the same as follows.

School fees: #61,800.00

Outfit: #16,000.00 (once for the academic session)

NOTE: All the fees should be paid with the issued tellers on or before **Monday September 5, 2022**. Please all fees should be paid in the student's full name. Students will collect **the list of books** after submission of bank teller & collection of receipt. More so, the Bursary office is always open from 9,00am to 2.00pm on Mondays to Fridays for change of receipts. Conversion of tellers to receipts on the day of resumption may no longer be obtainable.

2.07: TEXTBOOKS: Textbook imbibes reading culture, compliment and harmonize the teacher effort for the attainment of desirable results. Regrettably, most students are deprived of this companion. So as we prepare for new academic session, the seminary advises that parents/guardians should endeavor to equip their sons with recommended textbooks for the new class. These textbooks are available in the school bookshop at affordable prices.

2.08: ASSESSMENT DOCUMENT: The communication book and the worship attendance book given to your son are to be returned on the day of resumption. Please ensure that they are attended to accordingly. Any mutilation to any of the book will not be accepted by the school. Other documents for their utilization include: school magazine, newsletter as well as third term and promotion results, bio data form (which on return **MUST** provide the phone contact of the closest parent / guardian), Letter to his priest(only for SS1 – 3 students) and Subject Selection Form(only for SS1 – 3 students).

2.09 HOLIDAY ASSIGNMENTS/PROJECTS: These assignments can be accessed online. JSS 3 & SS 3 shall submit their assignment as they return for Extension classes on Saturday August 13, 2022. Whereas JSS 2 & SS 2 shall submit theirs on the day the Seminary shall resume for 2022/2023 Academic session. Parents are implored to ensure that their sons are busy with the Holidays assignments/projects. Please, as much as you can monitor the friends they keep and the places they visit during this holiday.

2.10 NATIONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (NIN): All prospective SS 2 & SS 3 students are expected to go for NIN registration and, submit evidence of the registration on the day of resumption. Parents are implored to be mindful of their son's particulars for the registration as all information shall also be used for their WAEC, NECO & JAMB registrations.
